Education gives children the foundation to succeed in school and in life.

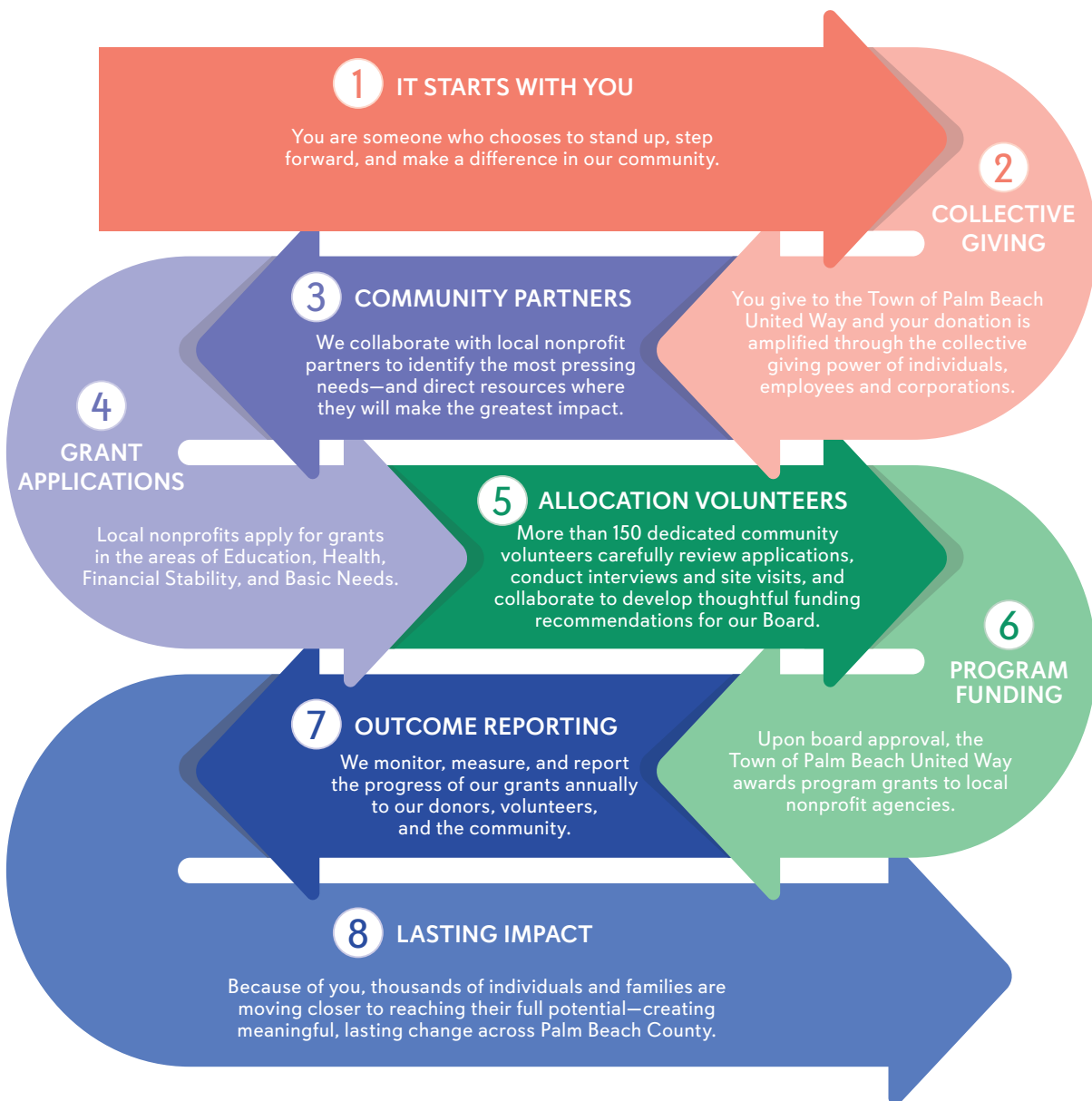
Financial Stability empowers families to achieve security, opportunity, and independence.

WE ARE TRUSTED AND EFFECTIVE

We hold a 4-star rating from Charity Navigator and a Platinum Transparency designation from Candid, the highest ratings possible from the nation's leading charity assessment organizations. We are volunteer-led, and volunteer-driven, with a network of more than 500 volunteers. Over the last six years, the Town of Palm Beach United Way has had an average operational overhead ratio of 8%, compared to the national nonprofit average of 25%.

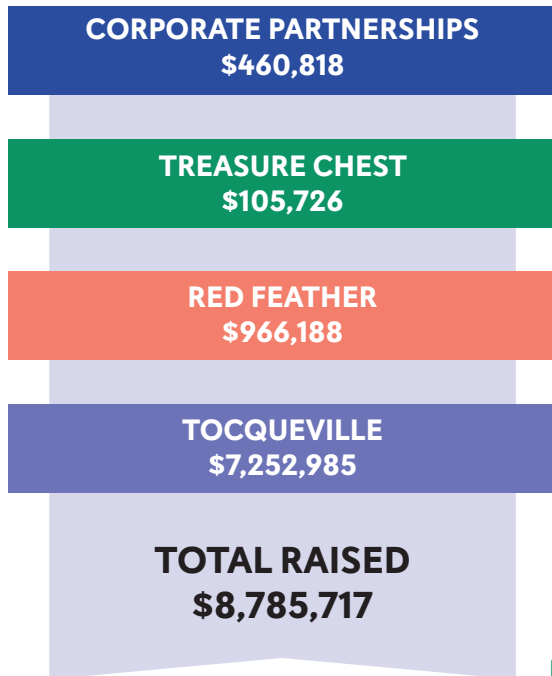
HOW YOUR DOLLARS LEAD TO CHANGE

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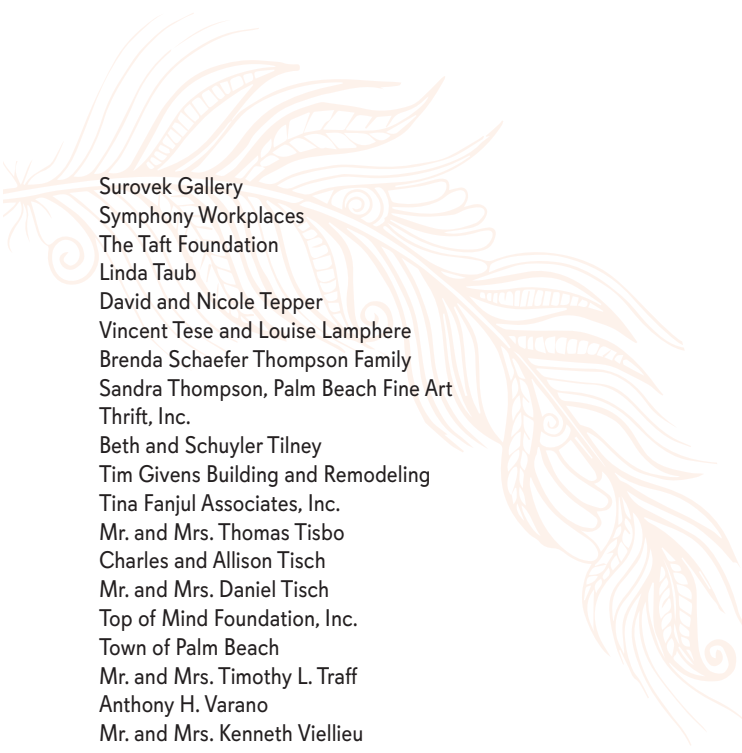

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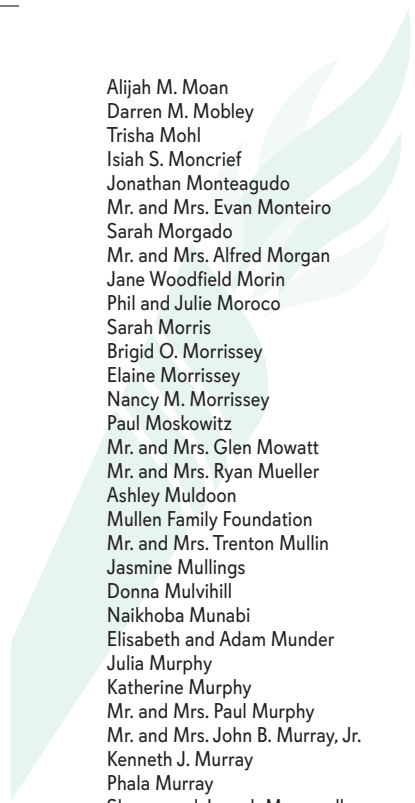

ALLOCATION COMMITTEE

The Town of Palm Beach United Way distributes funds to nonprofit partner agencies through a rigorous, volunteer-driven grant process—one that reflects our deep commitment to accountability, transparency, and measurable community impact.

Our Allocation Committee volunteers serve as the eyes and ears of thousands of donors, ensuring that every dollar entrusted to us is invested thoughtfully and responsibly. Over the course of three months, these dedicated community leaders devote countless hours to evaluating local needs and reviewing the programs and services provided by partner agencies. Volunteers analyze financial information, review audits and IRS Form 990s, conduct site visits, and meet directly with agency staff and board members to develop informed funding recommendations for the Board of Trustees.

Last year alone, **150 volunteers** evaluated **78 health and human service programs** throughout Palm Beach County. Together, they collectively contributed more than **1,400 volunteer hours**, traveled approximately **9,700 miles** to conduct firsthand program visits, and brought an extraordinary combined total of almost **900** years of professional and community experience.

Their dedication and diligence helps ensure that Town of Palm Beach United Way investments are strategic, impactful, and focused on addressing our community's most pressing needs.

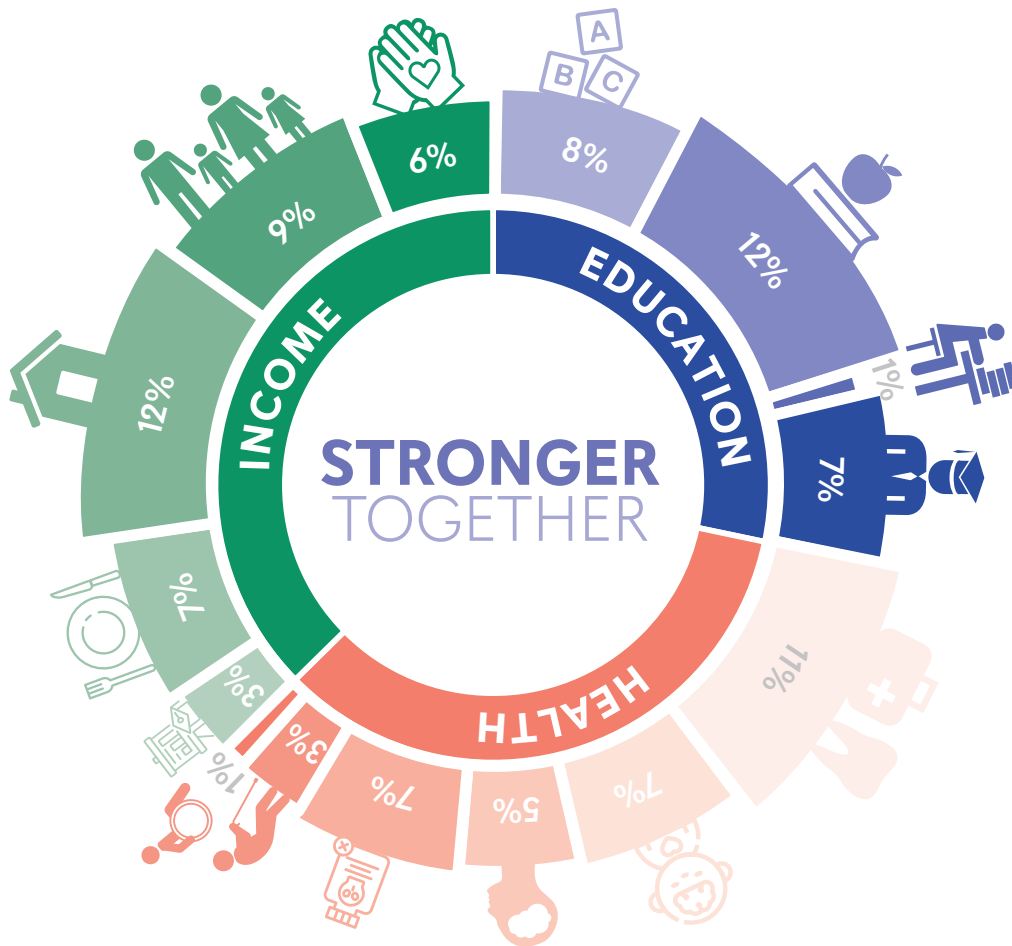


COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS

Bright, driven, and ambitious, Lilly is a seventh grade student from Lake Worth, determined to build a brighter future for herself. Defying the circumstances surrounding her, Lilly plans to become the first in her family to graduate from college.

But for Lilly, the road has not been easy. Her family has faced serious financial hardship, surviving on a limited income while struggling at times with the fear and uncertainty of homelessness. Despite those challenges, Lilly never stopped believing that education could change her future.

Last year, Lilly joined the Take Stock in Children program through support from the Town of Palm Beach United Way. That opportunity became a turning point in her life. Today, Lilly is paired with a caring mentor and a college success coach who encourage her, guide her, and remind her that her dreams are possible. Through weekly support, academic guidance, and long-term college planning, Lilly is gaining the confidence and stability she needs to succeed.

More than anything, Lilly wants to create a better future for her family and inspire others in her community to believe in themselves too.

With encouragement, opportunity, and people who believe in her, Lilly is no longer defined by the obstacles she faces—but by the future she is working so hard to build.

HEALTH GRANTS

Achieving and maintaining safety and physical and mental health is important in all stages of life and reaches beyond clinical care. Research shows that social, economic, and health behaviors contribute up to 70% of an individual's long-term health outcomes.

MEET SAM

At just nine years old, Sam was carrying burdens no child should have to bear.

After months of housing instability and ongoing conflict at home, Sam's anxiety began showing up everywhere—in stomachaches before school, emotional outbursts in class, and tears each morning when it was time to separate from his mother. Once an energetic and curious child, he had become fearful, withdrawn, and constantly on edge. His teachers noticed he struggled significantly both academically and emotionally, often losing focus and reacting strongly to minor situations. At home, his mother felt heartbroken watching her son battle fears she did not know how to ease.

Through a Town of Palm Beach United Way partner agency, Center for Child Counseling, Sam began receiving weekly Play Therapy and Cognitive Behavioral Therapy in a safe, supportive environment designed just for children. Slowly, he learned how to identify his feelings, calm his anxious thoughts, and build healthy coping skills through techniques like deep breathing and grounding exercises.

At the same time, Sam's mother received guidance and support to help create a stable home environment. Together, they began rebuilding a sense of safety, trust, and hope. Over time, the transformation was remarkable.

Sam started walking into school with confidence instead of fear. He began participating in class and group activities, his stomachaches subsided, and behavioral incidents became far less frequent. At home, evenings grew calmer, with fewer meltdowns and more moments of laughter and connection.

Today, Sam is thriving—not because his challenges disappeared overnight, but because caring people stepped in with the support his family needed at exactly the right time.

MEET JAMAL

WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS

NEARLY 49% OF PALM
BEACH COUNTY
HOUSEHOLDS STRUGGLE

At just 21 years old, Jamal had no place to call home. Without family support and after years of instability caused by mental health challenges within his family, he found himself quietly sleeping on the floor of a church laundry room each night—hoping no one would notice.

When the church learned of his situation, they connected him to Vita Nova. Within days, Jamal was welcomed into the Sleep Spot emergency shelter program, where he found safety, support, and hope for the first time in years.

Through Vita Nova’s drop-in center, Jamal received meals, healthcare, counseling, and guidance as he worked toward a more stable future. Together, Jamal and the Vita Nova team navigated housing applications and community resources.

This week, Jamal’s life changed again. He moved into transitional supportive housing at Vita Nova Village—a safe place to heal, grow, and begin building the future he deserves.

TEXAS FLOOD FUND

In early July 2025, in the wake of devastating flash floods that tore through the Hunt and Kerrville communities in Kerr County, Texas, the Town of Palm Beach United Way swiftly established the **Texas Flooding Fund** to provide urgent relief to those affected.

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, **\$188,260 was collected and distributed to four trusted frontline organizations**—Americares (\$25,000), Convoy of Hope (\$75,000), Global Empowerment Mission (\$63,260), and Team Rubicon (\$25,000)—delivering immediate and short-term support to individuals and families whose lives were suddenly upended. These funds helped provide critical essentials, including shelter, food, clean water, emergency supplies, and the resources needed to begin the long road to recovery.

This effort was further strengthened by the extraordinary generosity of the **Cathleen McFarlane Foundation**, whose matching support amplified the impact and extended help to even more families in need.

In moments of crisis, our community comes together—and through this collective compassion, hope is restored when it is needed most.



HURRICANE MELISSA

FUND

Hurricane Melissa roared ashore in Jamaica on October 28, 2025, as a catastrophic Category 5 storm, battering the island with 185 mph winds, blinding rain, and torrents of floodwater that surged through cities and neighborhoods. Trees were ripped from the ground and roofs torn away as one of the most powerful storms in recorded history unleashed its devastating fury.

In response, the Town of Palm Beach United Way created the Hurricane Melissa Recovery Fund to assist with relief efforts in Jamaica, Haiti, and other communities impacted by this devastating storm.

The fund raised nearly \$270,000 with the help of matching gifts from **Danielle Moore** and **Susan and Dom Telesco**.

Thanks to many generous donations, **\$269,604 was distributed** to Americares (\$50,000), Convoy of Hope (\$50,000), and Global Empowerment Mission (\$169,604) for emergency assistance such as food, water, medical care, supplies, hygiene kits, housing, and cleanup materials.



TURKEY TROT

OXBRIDGE YOUTH PHILANTHROPY

The Oxbridge Youth Philanthropy Initiative is an immersive, hands-on program led by the Town of Palm Beach United Way that empowers students to become thoughtful, informed changemakers in their community. Through this 20-week experience, students explored local needs, learned how nonprofit organizations operate, and engaged directly with community partners across Palm Beach County.

Meeting weekly on campus, students developed skills in financial literacy, nonprofit leadership, grantmaking, and collaborative decision-making through experiential learning designed to inspire leadership, service, and civic engagement. Throughout the program, students researched critical community issues, evaluated local nonprofit agencies, and identified organizations they believed would create the greatest impact through their services.

The program culminated in a student-led grantmaking process in which participants reviewed proposals, conducted evaluations, applied strategic decision-making, and collaboratively awarded funding to organizations making a measurable difference in the community. By combining education with real-world application, the initiative inspires the next generation of philanthropic leaders while strengthening a culture of service and giving in Palm Beach County.

The inaugural initiative was generously underwritten by **Susan and Bob Wright**. During the program's grant finale, students awarded grants to four Town of Palm Beach United Way partner agencies:
