

Turkey Trot

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CHIP TIMING

This is a chip-timed race, **NOT** a gun-timed race. That means your official race time begins when you cross the timing strip at the Start Line. Don't worry about your time being affected if you're starting in the back of the pack.

PETS/STROLLERS

Please, please please...it is very important that if you have pets or strollers or anything else that might slow down other runners, be courteous and **MOVE TO THE BACK** of the pack. Pets **MUST** be on a short leash! Long leashes have tripped runners.

RACE BIB

Remember to **WEAR YOUR OWN BIB**. Have it fastened to the front of you so the chip reads clearly as you cross the finish line. It will **NOT** read if it is on your back. Switching race bibs could affect race results and impact age category awards.

COURSE DIRECTIONS

Don't worry about getting lost on the course, there are volunteers and signs to guide you...and keep you entertained. The race begins and ends at Bradley Park. The final stretch is down the beautiful Lake Trail.

Turkey Trot

The Turkey Trot 5K will start and finish at the same point in front of the Biltmore Condo building located at 333 Sunset Avenue, Palm Beach, FL 33480 (west of Bradley Place, north of Bradley Park).

Start Line is on Sunset Avenue just north of the park and just south of the condo building.

Mile 1 is on the North County Road sidewalk about 35 feet north of the entrance to Phipps Estates Road.

Water Station is on the corner of North County Road and Plantation/Southland Rd.

U-Turn is in the road near North Lake Way and Via Linda and will be marked with an orange traffic barrel.


Mile 2 is on North Lake Trail about 20 feet south of Tanger Avenue.

Mile 3 is on North Lake Trail, just north of the dock at the Biltmore condo.

Finish Line is the same as the start line - located on Sunset Avenue as you make the turn off of the Lake Trail.

Course Notes:

- Bradley Place becomes North LakeWay north of Wells Road.
- When running along North CountyRoad, runners will be on the sidewalkon the west side of the road.
- The Lake Trail is a winding path thatruns along the Intracoastal Waterway.
